*Notes from the Nurses*

The County's vaccine plan submitted to the state in December outlines phase one of vaccine roll out. Following is what to expect:

- SCC Public Health Department will organize appointment-based vaccination clinics for skilled nursing facility personnel.
- Hospitals will receive their allocations directly and vaccinate their staff, beginning with those at highest risk.
- Large retail pharmacies will vaccinate people who live in certain types of nursing homes, through a program organized by the federal government.
- Healthcare providers will vaccinate their patients as they become eligible for vaccination and as there is more widespread availability of COVID-19 vaccines.
