Health & Wellness Program News

If you didn't know, we have extended the senior center hours to 7pm on Monday – Thursday and are offering later afternoon activities. Our office manager, Omeed, was hired to take over Jessica Carter's position after her retirement last spring. He is busy looking for enriching activities and programs to bring to the center. Make sure you sign up for Senior Center emails – many of the presenters are booked last minute and that is the best way for us to let you know what's happening. In the Health & Wellness Program, we still have a few spots open for the Empowered Caregiver: Building Foundations by Betty and Dave from the Alzheimer's Association. That's on Thursday, 2/5, 1pm – 2:30pm. You can sign up online or through the front desk. Their discussions are always worth the time

On Monday, 2/9, WelbeHealth will hold a Table Talk in our Fireside Lobby from 10am – 11:30am. WelbeHealth is a provider of care in the PACE model (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly). This system provides "wrap around" care for people on Medicare and Medi-Cal who might end up in a nursing home due to lack of supports. On Loc is the other PACE provider in our area. Members come to their centers to socialize, have lunch, see doctors and dentists on site, podiatry, and rehab. This is also how members can get services like scheduling appointments, home care, and home-delivered meals on the days the members don't attend lunch. It requires approval based on eligibility, and you would switch doctors to their providers, but this is an excellent, affordable way to stay living at home with lots and lots of help.
